



Visiting Guideline Update - Aug 14, 2020

So, after our most recent super thorough PLCB enforcement visit, some of the interpretation of the guidelines have changed yet again. The good news is we think we passed but we will have to make some changes. The only way to simply explain this will be based on where you are sitting.

### **Outside Porch and Inside the Winery (On Premises):**

You may consume wine, Slushees, beer and mixed drinks under the following conditions:

1. You must be seated at a table AND
2. You must have ordered a meal or brought one from home in the same transaction as the wine AND
3. Winery staff will serve your wine at your table.

A meal or voucher for a meal from an onsite vendor, if present, or the winery (pizza, cheese plate or cheese or meat plate), will be added to your alcohol purchase unless you bring your own food. We apologize but there are no exceptions as this is a state mandate. You may open a tab for the length of your visit (highly suggested) and you will only be charged once for a meal.

### **Lawn Areas and Music Events: (Off Premises):**

You may **only consume wine and Slushees** purchased from the winery. **We are not allowed to sell beer or mixed drinks for the lawn area. Beer or liquor is not allowed to be brought onsite or offsite.**

The following rules apply for the lawn area:

1. Guests will purchase their wine at our walk-up window or the door.
2. You are not required to sit at a table in the lawn area, just chairs are ok.
3. You do not have to order food when seated in the lawn area.
4. Lawn seating is on first-come-first-serve basis or bring your own chairs, pop-up tents, etc.

At all times, when not seated at a table or in the lawn area, guests are **required** to wear face coverings or a mask. This guideline includes bathroom trips and walking to and from your car. We usually welcome children and pets, but during this pandemic we ask that they remain home during this period.

Wine still can be ordered online for curbside pickup 7 days a week, from 11 a.m. – 6 p.m. Take out purchases are also allowed at the Walk-up Wine Window...during normal business hours.

Thank you for visiting us, helping us adhere to the Governor's ever-changing mandates and above all, for your continued patience as we continue to share our passion for wine.
