# WEATHERED

VINEYARDS & WINERY

As you may know, Governor Wolf and the Secretary of health on July 16, 2020 issued new guidance which now only allows us to serve you alcohol for onsite consumption under the following 3 conditions:

1. You must be seated at a table AND
2. You must have ordered a meal from the winery in the same transaction as the wine AND
3. Winery staff will serve you your wine at your table.

A meal or voucher for a meal from an onsite vendor, if present, will be added to your alcohol purchase. We apologize but there are no exceptions as this is a state mandate. You may open a tab for the length of your visit (highly suggested) and you will only be charged once for a meal. You will not be allowed to purchase wine in a to go format and open it onsite for consumption. Tables may not seat more than 6 people.

We have a limited number of tables, approximately 25, that can accommodate anywhere from 2 to 6 people. Tables provided by Weathered Vineyards will be offered on a first come first served basis. During larger music performances we strongly suggest visitors bring their own chairs and a table if possible. Once all the tables have been occupied any additional guests without their own table will need to wait in their car for a table to become available. We promise to work with all guests.

*How to order wine for onsite consumption when you arrive:*

Guests will place their orders at the wine walk-up window where they will be charged for a meal item and any beverages purchased. Weathered Vineyards staff will serve all guests at their table. At all times, when not seated at a table guests are required to wear face coverings or a mask. This includes bathroom trips and walking to and from your car. At this time we ask that all children and pets remain at home.

Wine can still be ordered online for curbside pickup 7 days a week from 11 am-6 pm. Take out purchases are also allowed at the Walk-up Wine Window...during normal business hours.

Thank you for visiting us, helping us adhere to the Governor's new mandates and above all, for your continued patience as it's the only way we can continue to share our passion for wine.
